Race Car/Pickup Safety Rules

- 1. Vehicle cannot be all wheel drive, must be front or rear wheel drive.
- 2. Must remove all glass, mirrors, tail lights, chrome, clips, outside door locks, door handles, emblems etc.
- 3. ALL flammable material must be removed from inside the vehicle.
- 4. Fire extinguisher must be mounted within the driver's reach and a dial type charge indicator gauge.
- 5. Numbers must be 18" tall and easily readable. MUST be on both sides of the car and the roof. Roof sign boards are ok and must have 16" tall numbers on both sides.
- 6. Batteries must be relocated inside the car. Must be securely mounted in a battery box, steel frame.
- 7. Must have a minimum of two (2) ratchet straps or seat belts holding the battery box securely to the floor. Steel boxes or trays recommended to hold battery.
- 8. Battery must be covered with rubber flap or non-flammable material.
- 9. No bungee cords allowed to secure anything on or in the car.
- 10. Driver's door window net or screen is mandatory.
- 11. Front window screen is mandatory.
- 12. **No profanity or inappropriate gestures on the car.** If found, you will be asked to cover it or remove it. Any refusal will result in disqualification.

Cage Components

- 1. Minimum of two (2) vertical post roll bars behind the seat with a side to side spreader bar. 2" x 2" diameter or larger, mounted to a 6"x6" steel plate top and bottom, attached with welding or four (4) bolts per plate.
- 2. Full roll cages with halos recommended.

Fuel System

- 1. Fuel system may be relocated to the rear seat area. Must have two straps holding the tank down. Must cover with a mud flap or non-flammable material.
- 2. If mounted in the trunk area, recommend a cage around for protection.
- 3. If running an electric fuel pump, you must paint an "E" on the roof and install an easy access shut off switch on the dash.
- 4. If fuel lines are run through the passenger compartment they must be inside a steel pipe, larger fuel line or plastic tubing.

Door and Door Bars

1. All doors must be welded or chained.

- 2. Exterior door bars ends must be cut at a 45 degree angle. Minimum of five (5) bolts per door bar
- 3. All bolts must be cut flush on the exterior.
- 4. Passenger door bars Mandatory. Two (2) rows of 4" pipe or two rows of internal roll cage door bars.
- 5. Minimum of two (2) rows of 4" side protection or three rows of internal roll cage door bars.

Hood and Trunk

- 1. All hoods and trunks must be chained, hood pinned or all-thread down. Minimum of two (2) chains, hood pins or all-thread for hood and trunk.
- 2. Hoods must have two (2) 6" holes for fire access and or inner fender wells removed.

Mud Flaps

- 1. All rear wheel drive must have a full wrap around mud flap. Floor mats are NOT mud flap material!!
- 2. All mud flaps must be a maximum of three (3) inches off the ground.
- 3. Mud flaps must be a minimum of 1/4"thick material.

Rules of Conduct

All persons in the pit must have a pit pass or driver wristband. Picture ID is required.

No minors will be allowed in to the pits – unless they are a driver/competitor only.

Persons between the ages of 15-17 may compete, but must have a current state issued drivers permit or license. It is also required for these drivers to have a parent or legal guardian accompany them to the pits and remain on the premises for the entire event. Both under-age driver and said parent or legal guardian, must sign the safety waiver upon entry of grounds.

No alcohol, drugs, or drinking in the pit area. No drinking before or during the event by any Driver or Crew. IF you show signs of being under the influence of drugs or alcohol your wristband will be cut off and you will be removed!!

No ATV/UTV vehicles, motorcycles, or golf carts allowed in the pit area (except those used by Officials).

No animals in the pit area whatsoever.

No speeding in the pit area whatsoever!

Keep the main access roadway clear at all times during the event.

All trailers/pit vehicles must be parked in designated area. No trailers or pit vehicles in the pits.

Belligerent behavior of any kind towards another competitor, crew member, spectator, security personnel, or official can result in YOU and your crew to be escorted out and forfeit any entry fees and winnings.

NO STANDING IN THE ENTRANCE OR EXIT TO THE ARENA AT ANY TIME DURING THE EVENT!

Anyone violating these rules may result in being asking to leave and will forfeit entry fees and winnings.

Flagger and Officials have the final say! There is a \$50.00 cash protest fee if you wish to challenge a call. IF you are found to be incorrect the person you are challenging will receive the \$50.00 dollars. IF you are correct the \$50.00 will be returned.
